What are the benefits of *My eHealth Record*?

Registering for My eHealth Record is voluntary and free.

My eHealth Record is an electronic record of your personal healthcare information that can be accessed by participating healthcare providers when needed for your ongoing healthcare.

My eHealth Record eliminates the need for you to rely solely on your memory. At the end of your appointment, your participating healthcare provider may send a summary of information to My eHealth Record. A summary may include information about medication you are taking, prescriptions, allergies, diagnostic test results etc. All participating healthcare providers can access this information for the purpose of providing you with healthcare.

By registering for My eHealth Record you consent to your information being accessed by participating healthcare providers, unless you say 'no' at the time of a visit. Access to My eHealth Record is controlled by you.

Participating healthcare providers will include a number of General Practices in urban and rural areas, hospitals, health centres and allied health practices within the Northern Territory.
